

**NAME**

ares\_cancel – Cancel a resolve

**SYNOPSIS**

#include <ares.h>

void ares_cancel(ares_channel channel)

**DESCRIPTION**

The **ares\_cancel(3)** function cancels all lookups/requests made on the the name service channel identified by *channel*. **ares\_cancel(3)** invokes the callbacks for each pending query on the channel, passing a status of **ARES\_ECANCELLED**. These calls give the callbacks a chance to clean up any state which might have been stored in their arguments. If such a callback invocation adds a new request to the channel, that request will *not* be cancelled by the current invocation of **ares\_cancel(3)**.
